Children's programs offered by the Eastman Community Music School have been developed by Donna Brink Fox, an Eastman School of Music professor who is a nationally recognized authority on early childhood music education. The program has attracted attention throughout the United States and abroad, and has been featured on network television.

Eastman early childhood music classes are **45 minutes** each and meet on **Saturdays** for **10 weeks**. **Class times are 9:00 a.m., 9:45 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 11:15 a.m., 12:00-noon, and 12:45 p.m.** (class times may be adjusted depending on enrollment)

The 10-week sessions are offered in the fall, winter, and spring.

Fall Session: September 17—November 19, 2016

Winter Session: January 7—March 11, 2017

Spring Session: March 18—May 20, 2016

Class Descriptions

All classes meet on Saturdays at 9:00, 9:45, 10:30, 11:15, 12:00-noon and 12:45 p.m.

Ten-week sessions begin
September 17, January 7, and March 18.

MusicTIME

A unique program for infants and toddlers (ages 4 months to 2 years) and their parents/caregivers. MusicTIME features musical activities that include songs, rhymes, bounces, tickles, moving to music, and listening. Information and guidance on musical development in young children and home-based activities is also provided. (\$140)

Music Times Two

A continuation of the objectives of MusicTIME for parents/caregivers and children (ages 2 to 3½-years). Children develop rhythmic and vocal skills as they engage in more independent music making activities that include: singing, movement, and playing hand-held instruments. (\$140)

Music Makers

Designed for 3½- and 4-year-old children without parental participation in the classes. Skills in singing, listening, and musical vocabulary are emphasized, with opportunities to play classroom percussion instruments. Visiting musicians demonstrate instruments throughout the session. (\$140)

Clef Club

This fourth level of the early childhood music program is intended for children who are enrolled in kindergarten or first grade or who are 5-6 years old. The class focuses on individual musical skills and includes singing, rhythmic activities, moving to music, musical concepts, musical games, and playing small percussion instruments. Children will begin foundational activities in reading and writing music. (\$140)

Registration Information

Spaces in our classes are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis at the beginning of each school year. The registration form is on page four of this brochure. Complete the registration form, detach and return it either by **mail** to *Eastman Community Music School, Eastman School of Music, 26 Gibbs Street, Rochester, NY 14604*, fax 585-274-1005, or **in person** to the *Community Music School Office on the 3rd floor of 10 Gibbs Street*. You may also **scan or photograph** the completed form and attach it to an **email** sent to earlymusic@esm.rochester.edu. Registration is not possible by phone. Please do not include payment with your form. We will bill you after classes begin.

Classes are formed based on enrollment and are in a state of flux until one week before a session begins. You will receive notification of your class time and room location one week before a session begins. Notification is sent via email.



For University of Rochester Employees*

After one year of full-time service or two years of part-time service, regular full-time faculty and regular full-time or part-time staff are eligible for a 25% reduction in charges for musical instruction through the Eastman Community Music School. To receive the discount, complete a tuition waiver form on the **Benefits Office** website. Tuition waivers are good for one year from July 1-June 30. The discounted tuition is \$105.00.

***Strong Memorial Hospital Residents and Fellows and Departmental Fellows** are not eligible for the reduction in charges for musical instruction through the Eastman Community Music School.



FAQ's about the Program



How long is each session? Each session is 10 weeks .

How do I register? The registration information on page two of this brochure outlines this process.

What is your re-registration policy? Priority registration for the Winter and Spring Sessions is offered to children who participate in the previous session. Enrolled students who wish to re-register for the next session must do so by week eight of their current session in order to be guaranteed a place in class. (See Early Childhood Dates to Remember below.)

My child will not be attending the fall session. When can I register for the winter or spring sessions? Families may submit a registration form for any session at any time. Forms are dated when we receive them. Students will be enrolled in open spaces in the order we receive the registration forms.

I have 2 children who are at different levels. Will I be able to get the same class time for both of them? We do our best to schedule siblings at the same class time. It is, however, sometimes difficult to do if there are fewer class times offered for one level than another or in cases of late registration.

If we have a conflict with the class time one week, are we able to come to a different time? Unfortunately no. Attending a different class time could lead to an overcrowded class. Additionally, moving students between classes during a session disrupts the class Routine and environment for the other children.

I have twins. What is the policy for parental attendance in the MusicTIME and Music Times Two classes? In an effort to foster adult/child interaction, twins (or siblings) enrolled in MusicTIME or Music Times Two, need an adult/child ratio of 1:1. Accompanying adults can be parents/guardians, family members, friends, or other caretakers.

Are there make-up classes in case of bad weather? There are no make-up classes for missed classes.

This is my child's first time to attend your program. What should I consider when deciding which level to choose? Consider the past experience and developmental level of your child. For example, a Music Times Two class is usually the best placement for a 3 1/2-year old child if this is his/her first introduction to our program. Children enrolled in Music Makers classes participate without their parents, so a strong sense of independence is helpful as the children take turns and interact with their peers in a more structured setting. Children who are not quite 5-years old but who are enrolled in kindergarten may attend Clef Club. Children who turn 5-years old in the spring may be more comfortable attending a Music Makers class. We are happy to help you determine correct placement.
